ew housing developments built in cornfields often require builders or homeowners to plant trees, and many plant fastgrowing ornamental trees that are relatively compact. In midtown, we enjoy the big canopies of shade trees planted a generation ago.

As you know from recent storms, these giants are also vulnerable. Storms, street and sewer repair, disease, poor pruning and management practices all weaken our trees and many have lived well beyond their expected life time. We need to plan for replacing them. Two guest speakers at the September 15 meeting will give us a new appreciation for our neighborhood's natural and man-made elements.

Chris Hall, Executive Assistant with Omaha By Design (OBD), will present their Place Game program. OBD works collaboratively with organizations and neighborhoods to "build a better Omaha". 
