President's Message

re had a very interesting presentation from Rivkah Sass, Executive Director of the Omaha Public Library System, at the January meeting. Rivkah pointed out that the library offers materials other than books, such as DVDs, and provides online access to materials such as newpaper articles. She also noted that the Willa Cather branch, which many in our area use, will be undergoing renovation.

We also had a presentation from Arnold Breslow of the Save Rosenblatt Committee describing the options for renovating Rosenblatt. He brought a plan showing how improvements could be made without tearing down the stadium and rebuilding it. The cost would range from \$25 million to \$60 million depending on the extent of renovation.

I should have mentioned this before winter got under way, but it's not too late since we could still get plenty of snow: If it looks like we're going to get a significant snowfall on the day of a meeting, watch the TV news for information on school closings. If OPS closes school on the day of a scheduled meeting, the meeting will be canceled. We really only have one more month to deal with this, but it could happen in March. Hopefully it won't.

Speaking of the March meeting: St. Matthew Church is having services on Maundy Thursday, which is the day of our regular meeting in March. Because of that, we will be meeting on Wednesday, March 19, at the church starting at the usual time. We will need to check with our scheduled speaker to make sure that date will work, so check the March newsletter for final information on the speaker for that meeting.


