





#### Celebrating International Women's Day on Leavenworth

I'm proud to be a woman who owns her own business. My store, The Humble Home, allows me to express my creativity, interact with some truly amazing pieces of home décor (some of which leave my store all too soon, but I'm not complaining!) and perhaps most importantly, be part of something bigger than myself.

According to a 2012 study commissioned by American Express, the US has an estimated 8.3 million woman-owned businesses and they're a growing at a rate of one and one-half times the national average. The growth rate in Nebraska is 34.8% over the last five years.

Omaha has many woman-owned businesses, but there's an unusual concentration on Leavenworth Street from 50th to 56th. This small stretch is home to businesses ranging from dance and yoga studios to restaurants and home décor. Gerda's, j.coco, Sharon Barnhart's Dance Studio, Spruce, Kate's Closet, Bhadra Yoga, McMillian Antiques, Legend Coffee, Weird Wild Stuff, and Tasty Pastry are all owned by women and each brings a unique style (and in some cases flavor) to the neighborhood.

We joined forces on March 8th of this year to celebrate International Women's Day, a day designated to celebrate the economic, political, and social achievements of women. The event was not conceived by just one person. It was truly a collaboration of many of the business owners on Leavenworth. We all brought ideas, time, and resources

to make it happen.

Participating businesses hung balloons outside to indicate a business owned by a woman. Some stores had sales, some served special appetizers, but all of them got to meet a lot of people they hadn't met before. A lot of the visitors to the Humble Home mentioned that they'd never known there were so many businesses in the area that were owned by women.

It could not have been a better day, and I'm pleased to be one of many businesses that call Leavenworth home. If you stopped in to see me or one of my neighbors that day, thank you so much! If you haven't had a chance to fully explore the variety of shops and restaurants our neighborhood offers, there has never been a better time than now.
