- tree brush (there will be vouchers to take them to River City Recycling)
  - vard waste
  - hazardous materials
  - paint, oil or herbicides

Hours of operation will be from 9am to 2pm. We will need volunteers, as usual, to monitor the site. Feel free to call if you would like to help. I will circulate a sign-up sheet at the March meeting. There will be a reminder about the cleanup in the April newslet-

# **Chemical Disposal Facility**

UnderTheSink, the Douglas/Sarpy County facility located at 4001 South 120th Street in Omaha for collecting and disposing of unwanted household chemicals is open. **By Appointment Only** call 444-Sink (444-7465) during business hours. Appointments are being made at 15-minute intervals.

#### UnderTheSink will be open year 'round .. hours:

Wednesday from 9am until 5pm

Thursday from 9am until 6:30pm

Friday from 9am until 5pm Saturday from 9am -1pm

Appointments are necessary to avoid traffic problems on South 120th Street and to ensure that the handling of the waste is done under conditions that are safe for the residents, the staff, and the environment.

Visit our website...www.underthesink.org, to learn about how to prepare for using the facility.

Materials that UnderTheSink receives will be reused, recycled, or properly disposed of through an off-site hazardous waste disposal contractor. There is no charge to residents for using the facility and residents may use the ReStore, where they may obtain, at no cost, leftover materials that are usable.

UnderTheSink is owned and operated by the City of Omaha on behalf of the residents of Douglas County and Sarpy County.
