Of Grants & Gardens - The Midtown Neighborhood Alliance (MNA) awarded AEPNA a \$300 Security National Bank grant to support AEPNA's pursuit of a community garden. We are exploring additional locations that have on-site water and more certainty than the original location. One possibility is the existing community garden at LifeGate Church (55th & Leavenworth). Another possibility is next to Gotta Be Me (51st & Pine). We still need about \$1000 to get the project going, but once we have a site and funding we can advertise available plots.


MNA has also put us in touch with a potential source of funding via a fireworks stand. If that opportunity comes through, we could raise close to \$4,000 to support the garden and other AEPNA projects, including signs! I'll keep you posted on the progress.




